RAPID FIRE SESSIONS

The concept of the Rapid Fire Session is to give people an idea of what your project or expertise is about, and to make them interested and wanting to ask questions about your work in the subsequent face-to-face meetings.

When: Rapid Fire Sessions will be held on April 4, 2019.

Who: Rapid Fire speakers will be selected from all the submitted abstracts. Presentations around a similar theme will be gathered.

Duration: 5 minutes. /!\ The timing will be strictly enforced.

Format: 3 slides maximum (in powerpoint or pdf format). /!\ Personal computers cannot be used. You will be invited to send your slides before the Forum.

POSTER SESSIONS

When: Two one-hour sessions will be held on April 3 & 4, 2018.

Duration: Posters will be verbally presented to respective facilitators of the organized sessions. The poster's author will have 3 minutes to present his/her poster.

Format: Poster size must be in portrait and A0 format (84.1 x 118.9 cm), installation will start from 9:00 on April 4, 2019. Display is allowed all along the Forum.

/!\ To locate it in the exhibition area and in the abstract book, each poster will be assigned a number. This number will be communicated upon your arrival at the Forum.

/!\ Posters related to Rapid Fire presentations may be presented during the poster sessions.

A best poster prize, valued at €500, will be attributed to each proposed theme. An award ceremony, chaired by the Cancéropôle CLARA and the Fondation ARC, will be held at the end of the congress.

OBJECTIVE

The aim of the R2B Oncology Meeting is to foster public-private partnerships by giving you the opportunity to pitch your project during the plenary session.

You will get the opportunity to present your project and your expertise, with the objective:

- To find partners to co-develop your project
- To make your expertise available to other projects (i.e. sharing specific equipment or know-how)

THEMES

The projects concern the discovery, development or optimization of:

- Cancer prevention
- Cancer diagnosis (validation of biomarkers for prognostic or diagnostic use, medical imaging...)
- Cancer therapy (drugs, vaccines, surgical devices, drug delivery, biosensors...).
- Patients' quality of life (reduction of treatments' toxicity and/ or side effects...)

The technological approaches may involve biotechnologies as well as medical technologies and digital technologies
